OPENING THOUGHT

IN OUR OVERSTIMULATED, ALWAYS-CONNECTED WORLD, IT'S EASY TO MISS THE ONE VOICE THAT MATTERS MOST—OUR SHEPHERD'S. JESUS SAYS HIS SHEEP KNOW HIS VOICE AND FOLLOW HIM. BUT CAN WE TRULY HEAR HIM IF WE DON'T FIRST QUIET THE NOISE?

KEY POINTS

- RECOGNIZE HIS VOICE FAMILIARITY WITH JESUS' VOICE GROWS THROUGH RELATIONSHIP, NOT RULE-FOLLOWING.
- Identify the Noise & the Thieves Cultural, emotional, and even internal voices can steal our peace and distort truth.
- Quiet the Noise of Doubt You are not held by your grip on God but by His grip on you.
- THE VOICE YOU LISTEN TO MOST BECOMES YOUR OWN OUR SPIRITUAL TONE IS SHAPED BY THE VOICES WE CONSUME.
- You Are Unsnatchable Jesus assures eternal security for those who are His.

- 5. What truths from John 10 bring you the most comfort or assurance in your relationship with Jesus?
