OPENING THOUGHT

KEY SCIPTURE VERSES

- 2 SAMUEL 6:22 & 24:24
- I Corinthians 4:10
- MATTHEW 6:20
- JOHN 12: 3 NLT THEN MARY TOOK A TWELVE-OUNCE JAR OF EXPENSIVE PERFUME MADE FROM ESSENCE OF NARD, AND SHE ANOINTED JESUS' FEET WITH IT, WIPING HIS FEET WITH HER HAIR. THE HOUSE WAS FILLED WITH THE FRAGRANCE.

KEY POINTS

- Love risks reputation—Mary chose worship over appearances.
- Love is beautiful—true devotion fills the room with the fragrance of Christ.
- Love leaves a legacy—what we pour out for Jesus lasts for eternity.
