OPENING THOUGHT

KEY POINTS

- Jesus connected authority with serving, not status.
- SERVICE TRANSFORMS US—IT'S NOT JUST INFORMATION BUT TRANSFORMATION.
- Every part of the body of Christ is essential.
- BELONGING MEANS BEING ACCEPTED AS YOU ARE, NOT EDITED TO FIT IN.
- The towel represents our mission—serving where God places us.
