OPENING THOUGHT

EVERY PERSON MUST DECIDE WHAT TO DO WITH JESUS. LIKE JUDAS, PETER, AND PILATE, WE ALL FACE MOMENTS WHEN WE EITHER TRADE HIM FOR TEMPORARY THINGS, DENY HIM UNDER PRESSURE, OR DISMISS HIM ALTOGETHER. BUT JESUS STILL OFFERS GRACE AND INVITES SURRENDER.

KEY SCIPTURE VERSES

- LUKE 22:61-62
- John I:29
- John 21:15-17
- ROMANS 12:1
- John 18 (NLT) Pilate said, 'So you are a king?' Jesus responded, 'You say I am a king. Actually, I was born and came into the world to testify to the truth. All who love the truth recognize that what I say is true.'

KEY POINTS

- Judas Sold Out He traded eternal value for temporary gain. What's your price?
- PETER DENIED FEAR SILENCED HIS FAITH. ARE YOU A THERMOSTAT OR THERMOMETER IN YOUR FAITH?
- PILATE DISMISSED HE KNEW THE TRUTH BUT REFUSED TO ACT ON IT.
- Jesus Restores Even when we fail, His grace calls us to surrender again.

- 5. What does true surrender to Jesus look like for you right now— today, this week, or this season?
