# KEY POINTS

- Fulfillment of Scripture Every detail of the crucifixion was intentional, proving God's sovereignty and faithfulness.
- It Is Finished "Tetelestai" means "Paid in full." The debt of sin is erased,
  and the way to the Father is open forever.
- Adopted by Grace Once spiritual orphans, we are now cherished children of God, loved and secured in His family.
